Explanation

In 2012, Creative Arts Workshops for Kids, Inc. (CAW) more than doubled its constituents reaching nearly 5,000 served. Highlights include the following: CAW provided more than twenty (20) extended after-school, in-school, Saturday and summer workshops in collaboration with more than 10 schools and community partners. Themes included the following: public health in collaboration with New York Presbyterian Hospital's school-based clinics, social justice with NYC Family Court, restorative justice with Lasting Investments in Neighborhood Connections, and Operation SNUG, and workforce labor with the Doe Fund. Culminating projects were presented to family, teachers, peers, and community leaders at government officials at institutions such as MOMA and the Maysles Institute. CAW's youth employment program employed seventy-nine (79) young people for seven weeks during the summer, in a transformative program resulting in five large-scale public works of art. The program and resulting murals were featured in the September article of the NY Daily News. Also, CAW participated in several community art-making and art education events including the annual Giraffe Path in conjunction with Hike the Heights - a collaborative celebration of health, wellness, art, and Northern Manhattan's parks. CAW co-produces this event each year together with over 30 community-based organizations. CAWs programs and youth-created artworks were featured in a summer-long exhibit entitled Flowers of the Past, Gardens of the Future in the lobby gallery of 1285 Avenue of the Americas.
